

Perkins Coie Litigation Team Secures Dismissal of Class-Action Lawsuit Against Oregon State University

PORTLAND (May 23, 2023)—A Perkins Coie litigation team successfully secured the dismissal of a class-action lawsuit against the Oregon State University before the U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon in relation to claims in the class action that remote classes had caused harm to students.

U.S. District Court for the District of Oregon Chief Judge Marco Hernandez dismissed the class-action lawsuit and reached the same conclusion as an Oregon state court in a former case against the University of Oregon (UO) that the same Perkins Coie litigation team managed for UO.
