Perkins Coie Client Endiatx Demonstrates Revolutionary Pillbot at TED2024 Vancouver

PALO ALTO (April 30, 2024)—Perkins Coie client Endiatx, which has developed the world's first motorized pill camera for telemedicine, demonstrated its revolutionary Pillbot at the <u>TED2024</u> Vancouver conference that has the potential to eliminate invasive medical procedures.

Endiatx co-founder and chairman Alex Luebke ingested one of the company's wireless micro robotic pills on the TED stage that was then navigated around his stomach by Endiatx co-founder Vivek Kumbhari through the use of a game controller. Vivek is also a professor of medicine and chair of the Mayo Clinic's Division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology.
