This October, the Department of Education is slated to make sweeping <u>changes</u> across <u>Title IX</u>'s implementing regulations. The expansive proposed revisions would impact college and university <u>grievance procedures</u>, which are designed to promptly and equitably resolve complaints alleging discrimination on the basis of sex.

Federal departments and agencies typically make only micro-adjustments to general and permanent rules in the Code of Federal Regulations. But the DOE's 2022 proposed Title IX <u>rulemaking</u> stood out because of its size (700 pages) and its <u>ambition</u>.
