*Richards v. Safeway, No.* 13cv4317 (N.D. Cal.): Plaintiffs allege that frozen waffles labeled "100% Natural" contain an allegedly "synthetic" ingredient, sodium acid pyrophosphate. <u>Complaint.</u> *Swearingen v. Attune Foods, No.* 13cv4541 (N.D. Cal.): Plaintiffs allege that Attune's chocolate bars, Erewhon crackers and cereals, and Uncle Sam's cereals are "misbranded" because the labels list ECJ as an ingredient rather than sugar. <u>Complaint.</u> *Marty v. Anheuser-Busch Cos., No.* 13cv23656 (S.D. Fla.): Plaintiff alleges that Anheuser-Busch has misled consumers and charged a premium price for Beck's beer, which the complaint alleges is marketed as a high quality German beer, when it is manufactured in the U.S. with domestic ingredients. Complaint.
