Automatic Recount Underway for Oregon GMO Labeling Initiative

Update to this post on December 16, 2014 found [here](#). After many in Oregon concluded that voters had rejected an Oregon GMO labeling initiative, the results show that Measure 92 failed by only 812 votes out of [1.5 million votes cast](#). This triggers an automatic hand recount of ballots. Oregon Secretary of State Kate Brown has called for counties to [complete the recount](#) by December 10, 2014. [Measure 92](#) would require food manufacturers and retailers to label foods as "genetically engineered."
