### **1.1 Primary Laws and Regulations**

#### **The Controlled Substances Act**

In the United States, psychedelic substances are regulated through both federal and state laws. On the federal side, the main governing statute is the [Controlled Substances Act](#) (CSA) of the Comprehensive Drug Abuse Prevention and Control Act of 1970. See *Gonzales v Oregon*, 546 U.S. 243 (2006). The CSA establishes a comprehensive federal scheme to regulate the manufacturing and distribution of controlled substances.
